## CAP CLASSIQUE

### **Graham Beck Brut** *Robertson*

**R400 / 70**

Light yeasty aromas and secondary tones of limey fresh fruit on the nose with rich creamy complexity on the palate.

*Pinot Noir, Chardonnay*

### **Graham Beck Brut Rose** *Robertson*

**R410**

Whiffs of raspberries, cherries and aromas of minerality. Hints of oyster shell and fresh lavender.

*Pinot Noir, Chardonnay*

### **Le Lude** *Franschhoek*

**R615**

Elegant citrus blossoms with fresh lime aromas followed by nougat, roasted nuts and brioche.

*Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinotage, Pinot Meunier*

### **Le Lude Rose** *Franschhoek*

**R625**

**Ripe** cherry and raspberry aromas provide a delicate profile to the wine. Hints of grapefruit, wild rose, blueberries and aniseed.

*Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier*

### **Silverthorn The Green Man** *Robertson*

**R615**

Fresh aromas of green apple and acacia blossom backed by subtle hints of minerality and whiffs of freshly baked brioche.

*Chardonnay*

## CHAMPAGNE

### **Nicholas Feuillatte** *Chouilly*

**R1350**

Fresh white fruit aromas of apple, pear and peach intermingle with curry and turmeric spices.

*Pinot Noir, Chardonnay*

### **Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial** *Epernay*

**R1550**

Vibrant intensity of green apple and citrus fruit with mineral nuances and white flowers. Secondary notes of brioche, cereal and fresh nuts.

*Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay*

### **Moët & Chandon Nectar Imperial** *Epernay*

**R1800**

A burst of exotic pineapple and mango rounded off by stone fruit nuances and hints of vanilla.

*Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay*

### **Veuve Clicquot** *Reims*

**R1750**

Fruity notes reminiscent of pear flesh with discreet biscuit notes in the background.

*Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay*

### **Billecart-Salmon Brut Rose** *Mareuil-sur-Ay*

**R1795**

A delicate bouquet of red fruits and the zest of citrus followed by a fresh finish with a taste of raspberry.

## WHITE CULTIVARS

### RIESLING

**Jordan The Real McCoy** *Stellenbosch*

**R290**

Aromatic tropical fruit with orange zest spicy edges and crisp acid combine elegantly in this appealing off-dry wine.

**Spioenkop** *Elgin*

**R545**

Pepper, lime and spice – all delivered in a light bodied wine with verve. A hint of sugar prolongs the flavour of this very enjoyable wine.

### SAUVIGNON BLANC

**Neil Ellis Groenekloof** *Darling*

**R250 / 65**

A freshly acidic character that mixes happily with citrus and tropical notes a well composed palate.

**Almenkerk** *Elgin*

**R325**

This single-vineyard wine is crafted to be the ultimate expression of Elgin's cool climate: Elegant, complex with a core of minerality. A true terroir wine, it offsets the typical green aromas of Sauvignon Blanc with the tropical tones of fully ripened fruit.

**Iona** *Elgin*

**R355**

Showing plenty of ripe fruit due to the late harvest, this wine has a full, balanced palate with plenty of citrus on the nose.

**David Niewoud Ghost Corner** *Elim*

**R495**

Concentrated layers of green figs and gooseberries with a touch of grapefruit, fynbos and a steely minerality on the palate.

### CHENIN BLANC

**Cederberg** *Unwooded Cederberg*

**R230 / 55**

Beautiful layers of melon, grapefruit and fleshy white pear. A mouth coating creaminess comes from 5 months on the lees. It finishes with a lively crisp acidity. Altitude vineyards make this chenin unique.

**Kloof Street** *Swartland*

**R220**

Pale straw in colour, this wine has a nose of sun ripened pears and wet granite. The palate is full and rich with a mineral spicy finish.

**Spioenkop** *Elgin*

**R345**

Sophisticated flavours of pineapple, peach and extract of almond. The wine has a good balance between the lemon acidity and slightly wooded flavours.

**RemhoogteHoneybunch** *Stellenbosch*

**R400**

Intense honeyed fragrance. The nose shows fresh peaches and apricots complemented by aromas of floral honeysuckle and freshened by undertones of lime.





## SEMILLON

### **Steenberg** *Constantia*

**R490**

Aromas of dried apricots, peaches and vanilla on the nose. The palate is rich and creamy with lime and citrus notes followed by hits of elderflower and tangerine in the aftertaste.

## VIOGNIER

### **Alvi's Drift** *Worcester*

**R200**

A white wine for red wine drinkers. Aromas dominated by apricots and white peaches. The fruit is nuanced with a hint of cashew nuts.

## CHARDONNAY

### **WarwickThe First Lady** *Unoaked Stellenbosch*

**R220 / 60**

A pale straw colour with a hint of green in the glass. Intense nose of fresh pineapple, lemon, citrus and floral notes.

### **Bouchard Finlayson Crocodile's Lair, Kaaimansgat** *Overberg*

**R395**

Beautifully fresh and crisp with obvious gooseberry flavours surrounded by subtle oak nuances as well as a distinctive mineral quality.

### **Paul Cluver Estate** *Elgin*

**R550**

Lots of buttered toast on the nose with a distinctive citrus presence. Tangerine and citrus blossom fragrances with hints of vanilla pod and almond flakes.

## WHITE BLENDS

### **Spier Creative Block 2** *Coastal Region*

**R260**

Bordeaux style blend with ripe kiwi fruit and white peaches on the nose with an intense green grassy undertone. Perfumed green winter melon with an undertone of green asparagus. Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon

### **Thorne & Daughters Rocking Horse** *Western Cape*

**R545**

Aromas of gooseberry, naartjie peel, peach, lavender, rosemary and burnt sugar. Broad rich flavours resolve into an oysterbed salinity. Chenin Blanc, Rousanne, Semillon, Chardonnay

### **MullineuxWhite** *Swartland*

**R520**

A nose of ripe green citrus fruit and Christmas spices. A fresh and richly textured palate of ripe pears, almonds and peaches with a clove-like finish. Chenin Blanc, Clairette Blanche, Viognier, Semillon Gris

## ROSÉ / BLANC DE NOIR

### **Olifantsberg** *Worcester*

**R230 / 60**

Salmon pink in colour, this delightful wine has beautiful savory notes and a refreshing creamy palate. Syrah

### **AlmenkerkLace** *Elgin*

**R275**

Aromas of ripe raspberry and watermelon are complemented on the palate by a savoury character. Cabernet Sauvignon





## RED CULTIVARS

### PINOT NOIR

**Newton Johnson Family Vineyards** *Hemel-en-Aarde Valley* **R495**  
Pure and precise characters of fragrant cherries, currants, earthiness and spice. The perfume and silky smooth tannins are complemented with depth provided by red clay deeper in the soil. Selected as one of the top 3 Pinot Noirs outside of Burgundy by Decanter magazine.

**Bouchard Finalyson Galpin Peak** *Hemel-en-Aarde Valley* **R795**  
Peppery spice with blackberry and cherry notes ending in a harmonious and long earthy finish.

**Storm Vrede** *Upper Hemel-en-Aarde valley* **R1150**  
Displays richness and generosity with alluring and opulent fruit perfume. Not flashy or overly fruity but shows depth, purity and structure. Characteristic of the site's low vigour, stoney, clay rich Bokkeveld shale soils.

### CINSAULT

**Naude** *Stellenbosch* **R1250**  
An extraordinarily pretty wine. The nose shows red cherry, raspberry, pomegranate, wild flowers and herbs. Lovely fruit purity, fresh acidity and fine tannins – it possesses plenty of detail and real poise.

### PINOTAGE

**Diemersfontein** *Wellington* **R280**  
Distinct coffee, rich dark chocolate and baked plums on the nose with ripe, subtle tannins. A wine to be enjoyed young.

**Remhoogte Bushvine** *Stellenbosch* **R345**  
Ultra fresh with cherries and mulberries dominating the nose with hints of fynbos and a slight earthiness bringing depth. Chalky tannin and fresh spice provide a savoury finish

**Spioenkop 1900** *Elgin* **R865**  
A complex, subtle nose of blackcurrent, violet, cinnamon and black cherries. An elegant Pinotage with a lingering aftertaste.

### CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**Warwick The First lady** *Stellenbosch* **R310 / 65**  
The bouquet reveals dark chocolate, brambleberries, star anise, cloves, cracked black pepper and notes of fresh thyme.

**Cederberg** *Cederberg* **R435**  
Loads of blackcurrants with cedar wood undertones on the nose with a hint of smokiness and tobacco leaf, creating a complex wine.

**De Trafford** *Stellenbosch* **R870**  
Classic dark fruit, iodine and graphite spicing with nuances of liquorice.





## MERLOT

### **Hartenberg** *Stellenbosch*

**R485**

Brick red in colour. A mélange of aromas permeate the nose, showing truffles, forest floor, violets, plums and cherry.

### **Meerlust** *Stellenbosch*

**R715**

Intense dark fruit on the nose, mulberry and damson plum with hints of dark chocolate and spice.

### **De Trafford** *Stellenbosch*

**R1450**

Pure dark red berry and cherry fruit with intriguing nuts and spices and a little herbaceous character. These flavours follow through on the palate with lovely fine, dry tannins and a soft long finish.

## SHIRAZ

### **La Motte** *Franschoek*

**R395**

This wine beautifully captures juicy berry - fruit, sweet liquorice, violet flowers and pepper spice.

### **Kevin Arnold** *Stellenbosch*

**R645**

Floral, perfume notes and clove pepper spice lead the aromatics of this Shiraz, accompanied by soft leather and licorice undertones.

Shiraz, Mourvedre

### **De Trafford** *Stellenbosch*

**R1450**

Forthcoming spicy, blueberry fruit, herbal fynbos notes, and white pepper on the nose.

### **Mullineux Iron Syrah**

**R2215**

Platter's guide red wine of the year. Hints of black pepper, dark berries and herbs and a bloody, earthy character on the nose.

## RED BLENDS

### **Kloof Street Swartland Rouge** *Swartland*

**R290 / 80**

The seductive blend of Southern Rhône varieties has a perfumed nose of violets, spice and purple fruit.

Syrah, Grenache, Carignan, Mourvedre, Tinta Barocca, Cinsault

### **AA Badenhorst Family Red** *Swartland*

**R710**

Complex notes of pepper, liquorice, perfume, and black cherries. The palate entry is quite dense with lavender and dark berry fruit.

Shiraz, Cinsault, Tinta Barocca, Grenache, Mourvedre

### **Warwick Trilogy** *Stellenbosch*

**R950**

The wine displays an intense ruby red colour in the glass. The bouquet is reminiscent of vanilla, cassis, thyme liquorice and mulberries.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot

### **Ormond Vernon Basson** *Darling*

**R915**

A deep crimson red wine with hints of vanilla, flamed cherries, blueberries and earthiness.

A taste of dark fruits along with a savoury character and toasty oak finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc.

A tête-de-cuvée of the best Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon barrels from a supreme vintage

### NEDERBURG AUCTION

**Durbanville Hills** *"Biesjes Craal" Sauvignon Blanc 2009 Durbanville* **R995**  
Small-batch production from site-specific vineyards, with a mineral and herbaceous core

**Nederburg** *"Private Bin R121" Shiraz 2006 Paarl* **R1295**  
Seductive and spicy, with a Cedarwood spice and velvety, leather undertones

**Nederburg** *"Private Bin R172" Pinotage 2006 Paarl* **R1695**  
Full-bodied, ripe, with stewed purple fruit and an earthy finish





## DESSERT WINES

**Donkiesbaai Hooiwijn** *Piekenierskloof*

**R515 / 85**

Ripe apricots, stewed peaches and subtle rooibos tea come to the fore with a light touch of honeycomb and caramel. This wine has a fantastic balance between sugar and acidity, and an integrated long-lingering finish.

Chenin Blanc

**Ken Forrester Noble T** *Stellenbosch*

**R555**

A barrel fermented botrytised dessert wine. Fresh, sumptuous peach, dried apricot flavours, overlaid with a tropical lushness of melon and pineapple. Ripe sweetness, yet tangy, with flavours like baked apples with clove spice, wood spice and honey on the finish.

Chenin Blanc

**MullineuxOlerasay** *Swartland*

**R1100**

Bright golden straw colour, with a rich, viscous appearance. The nose and palate are a complex, enticing blend of dried peaches, apricots, honey and marmalade, with a savoury nuttiness. The intense mouth-feel is balanced by a clean, fresh, and very long finish.

Chenin Blanc

**Klein Constantia Vin De Constance** *Constantia*

**R2150**

Concentrated flavours of apricot and orange zest with aspects of frangipani flowers abound. Mouth filling yet clean and focused, the wine tapers into a rich luscious finish.
